

LINCOLN HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

To receive a diploma, students need to meet the following requirements:

Proficiency Requirements:

State law requires that graduates will have to reach a minimum standard of proficiency in reading, writing, and mathematics in order to receive a diploma from graduation from High School.

Pass Algebra 1

Students are required to pass the High School Exit Exam (CAHSEE) to receive a diploma

Subject Requirements/Credits:

(1) English	40 credits
(2) Math (including Algebra 1) - Students must enroll in math in their 9 th and 10 th grades.	30 credits
(3) Science	20 credits
(4) Physical Education -Requirement of all freshmen.	20 credits
(5) Health/Dr Education	10 credits
(6) Social Sciences -World History - 10 th grade -U.S. History or AP U.S.History- 11 th grade -Government/Economics - 12 th grade	30 credits
(7) Fine Arts	10 credits
(8) Computer Literacy credits	5
(9) Electives	95 credits

TOTAL credits required for graduation =	260 credits
